Privacy Notices for Aetna Funding Advantage

Great news! We've finished the 2017 1095-B reporting for Aetna Funding Advantage (AFA) members. And now, we're adding another resource to make your life easier. [Here is our new HIPAA privacy policy toolkit.](#)

As a self-insured plan sponsor, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) requires that you provide privacy policy notices to your employees. **With AFA, we make it simple.** Our toolkit provides the resources you need to meet the HIPAA notice of Privacy Practices requirement. It helps you explain to employees how your business (as the plan sponsor) and Aetna may use and disclose personal health information.

The toolkit includes:

- Instruction document with background about the HIPPA Privacy Practices notice requirement
- Notice template you can use to develop a privacy communication to your employees

If you choose to implement the toolkit, you may also want to consider appointing a Privacy Officer that employees can direct concerns to at your company. Annually, we'll send you a template you can use to remind employees of your privacy policy.
