The new CVS-Walmart agreement enables Walmart to continue participating in the CVS Caremark commercial and managed Medicaid retail pharmacy networks. The agreement offers enhanced network stability, and prevents disruption for clients and employees.

With the continuing participation of Walmart, the CVS Caremark national pharmacy network will have nearly 68,000 participating pharmacies for members to choose from, including independently-owned, community-based pharmacies, other local pharmacies in grocery stores and mass merchants, as well as regional and national chains. As a reminder, Aetna members can login to the Aetna member website and Aetna mobile to check their provider directory for pharmacies in their area.
