## Virginia Notice of Subsidy Eligibility

The Virginia Exchange sent notices to members about subsidy eligibility and the Open Enrollment Periods the last two weeks of October. Most Virginia members should have received their renewal notices from CareFirst BlueCross BlueShield.

The following four letters were distributed to members based on their eligibility status:

**Financial help** - enrolled and eligible for APTC and income-based CSR, but may be eligible for different financial assistance.

**Losing financial help** - enrolled and currently eligible for APTC and income-based CSR, but not eligible for financial assistance in 2017.

**Must update application** - automatically re-enrolled in 2015 and 2016 with APTC and income-based CSR from their 2014 and 2015 tax returns. These members must now update their application in order to receive financial assistance in 2017.

**Non-financial help** (state expanded Medicaid) - currently enrolled in a Marketplace plan without financial assistance for 2016, but may be eligible for Medicaid in 2017.
