## Error Found – 2018 ACA Washington, D.C. Sales Book

The vision coverage benefit for children up to age 19 contained an error. We incorrectly stated that all plans were eligible for one no-charge in-network routine exam per calendar year. This statement is not correct for the Bronze Standard Plans which requires a \$50 in-network fee for one routine exam per calendar year.

The chart below shows the correction to the vision benefit located on page six of the book.
