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Dominion National Awarded Second-Consecutive Seven-Year Contract to Offer Dental Benefits for Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program

Arlington, VA - Dominion National, a leading dental and vision insurer and administrator headquartered in Arlington, Va., was selected by the U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) as a regional dental carrier to offer dental benefits for the Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP) for a second-consecutive seven-year contract.
